

Tips for hosting a successful vaccine forum

How to effectively reach people with vaccine concerns



Come ready to listen.

Collect anonymous questions prior to the event.

Listen closely to questions and concerns.

Leave assumptions at the door.

Don't persuade; only provide information.



Be intentional about your speakers.

Include speakers who reflect the audience.

Consider participants' race, age, profession, and gender.



Keep the conversation going.

Share additional resources after the event.

Consider making it a series with multiple sessions.

Reach out to unvaccinated people in person or through text or email.

Maintain regular communication to address questions and concerns as they arise.
